Entries Open: Friday, September 6, 2018 at 8:00 AM. All entries received before this date will be returned. Entries will be accepted on a first-received basis.

Entries Close: Wednesday, November 7, 2018 at 6:00 PM. After this time, entries cannot be accepted, canceled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and Chapter 3, Section 1 of the Regulations for Herding Tests and Trials.

Entries Limited to 50 runs per event. Drawing for running order will be made at the trial secretary's address on Friday, November 9, 2018 at 7:00 PM. Day of test entries will be accepted, if maximum limit is not reached.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

TRIAL SITE will be open from 8:00 AM to ½ hour after the event ends. Dogs may not be left overnight. There is little protection from the weather at the site. Please bring shade cloth, tents and chairs with you. A water hose and/or water bath will be available to water down your dog in the event of hot weather. Event will be held “rain or shine.”

COURSE WALK: 8:30 AM walk-thru for Event #1 (suggested but not required); 10:00 AM walk-thru for Event #2 (suggested but not required).

NO FOOD will be available on site.

ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS TO ENTER FDC TEST: Open to all dogs at least 9 months of age. Females in season may not enter. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to enter provided, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the entire test course.

DOGS ON GROUNDS: *You are responsible for picking up after your dogs and disposing of waste in proper receptacles.* All dogs present must be held on a proper FIXED-LENGTH leash (**NO “FLEXI-TYPE” RETRACTABLE LEASHES ALLOWED**). **No soft crates allowed. No prongs or electric collars.** Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting herding stock nor to interfere outside the testing area with another dog’s performance in the test areas. Un-entered dogs are not allowed in the test/trial areas.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

ENTRY INFORMATION

If sending entries overnight, make sure to **sign the waiver** that allows the delivery person to leave packages without a signature. Requiring a signature will only delay receipt of your entries.

Taconic Hills Kennel Club, Inc. its officers and representatives, the Trial Chair, Secretary, Committee, and the owners of the trial site assume no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors' property and their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. Owners or handlers entering a dog in the Test/Trial do so at their own risk and also agree to abide by the Rules of The American Kennel Club and the most recent version of the AKC Herding Regulations.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY.

ENTRY FEE(S): \$35 per event. Entries close Wednesday, November 7, 2018 at 6 pm. Running order entries drawn Friday, November 9, 2018 at 7:00 PM at Trial Secretary's residence.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms (whoever may make such errors) and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print clearly and carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors. The Trial secretary is not responsible for illegible (in the opinion of the Trial Secretary) entry form information.

DECLINED ENTRIES: Taconic Hills Kennel Club, Inc. may decline any entries and may remove any dog on any account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against the aforementioned mentioned club or any official or member thereof.

ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event a dog is absent, not allowed to compete in the entered test, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the Test, no refund of entries will be made.

ALTERNATE LIST POLICIES: When entry limits are reached, all additional entries received prior to closing will be added to an alternates list in the order entry was received. The alternates list will be used to fill vacancies that occur in the drawn running order, with the first available alternate entry replacing the first vacancy in the event entered.

ROUTES TO THE EVENT SITE

From NYC & South:

Take the Taconic State Pkwy North to Underhill Avenue Exit. Turn right onto Underhill Avenue. Follow Underhill Avenue for 1.8 miles. Turn right to stay on Underhill Avenue. In another 0.2 miles turn right onto Hanover Street. In 0.3 miles, turn left onto Moserman Avenue. The Grange fairgrounds will be on your right.

From Putnam County and North:

Take the Taconic Parkway south to the Underhill Avenue Exit. Turn left onto Underhill Avenue and follow directions above.

From Connecticut:

Follow I-84 West to Exit 16 South for the Taconic Parkway South. Take the Taconic Parkway to the Underhill Avenue exit and follow directions above.

From NJ and Rockland County:

Tappan Zee Bridge to Exit 8A for Saw Mill Parkway North. Follow the Saw Mill Parkway to Exit 26 for the Taconic Parkway. Take the Taconic Parkway to the Underhill Avenue exit and follow directions above.
